|--------------------------|--|
| One Body                 | The same Head (Jesus Christ) controls each believer                      |
| One Spirit               | The same Holy Spirit indwells each believer                              |
| One Hope Of Your Calling | The same hope of Christ's return inspires each believer                  |
| One Lord                 | The same Lord rules each believer  |
| One Faith                | The same Scripture guides each believer                                  |
| One Baptism              | The same baptism of the Holy Spirit identifies each believer as one Body |
| One God And Father       | The same Heavenly Father adopts each believer                            |
