Signs Of An Unhealthy Church



- Entitlement how am I being served is more important than how am I serving others
- **Toxic Culture** fear and shame motivates rather than grace and love
- Authoritarian Leadership – leadership micromanages, is defensive and places pastoral authority over servant leadership
- **Legalism** non-biblical moral controls are imposed
- **Controlled Narrative** unwilling to evaluate traditions biblically and avoiding hard questions
- **Hypocrisy** what's said is different than what's done
- **Rivalries** competition over partnership
- Neglects Great Commission – ignores local and worldwide evangelism and discipleship


• Worthy = axios
